For what reason has the Department of Environment decided to introduce a gate entrance situated at the bottom of Harding's Road, at the top of the foreshore at Europa Point?

ANSWER

Europa Foreshore forms part of the wider Gibraltar Nature Reserve. A gate has been installed to help protect this component of the reserve by restricting access during the night. This follows repeated acts of vandalism and significant littering in the area, including foreign anglers entering the site in the silent hours to evade the authorities. How many young people were provided with Residential Care by the Care Agency in 2024, broken down by age and whether they remain in such care or not?

ANSWER

The Care Agency has a duty of care for young persons who enter Residential Care until that person reaches the age of 26 years, and until such time as that young person either is adopted or fostered, returns to their biological parents, or is moved into a permanent home in their name.

Throughout the year 2024 there were 61 young persons provided with Residential Care by the Care Agency.

Of these young persons, 44 remain in Residential Care as of this month (January 2025), with 17 having left Residential Care within the year 2024.

The breakdown by age is as follows:

Over the past nine months, we have strengthened the Income Tax Office by bolstering expert resources, enabling a more targeted and effective approach to tax compliance.

Key measures, including taxing interest income for insurers and DLT firms, restricting the carry-forward of tax losses, implementing the top-up tax on multinationals and OECD global minimum corporate tax rate, will further support our efforts.

While the results are encouraging, we remain mindful that future revenues will depend on sustained compliance, economic conditions, and the continually evolving tax landscape.
