# THE CERTIFICATE OF THE PRINCIPAL AUDITOR TO THE GIBRALTAR REGULATORY AUTHORITY

I certify that I have audited the financial statements of the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority for the financial year ended 31 March 2015 in accordance with the provisions of Section 15(2) of the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority Act 2000. These statements comprise the Receipts and Payments Account, the Capital Account, the Balance Sheet and the related notes. These financial statements have been prepared using the cash receipts and disbursements basis of accounting.

# Respective responsibilities of the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority and the Principal Auditor

The Gibraltar Regulatory Authority is responsible for the preparation of the financial statements and for being satisfied that they give a true and fair view. The Gibraltar Regulatory Authority's policy is to prepare the financial statements on the cash receipts and disbursements basis. On this basis revenue is recognised when received rather than when earned, and expenses are recognised when paid rather than when incurred.

My responsibility is to audit, certify and report on the financial statements in accordance with the provisions of Sections 15(2) and 15(4) of the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority Act 2000. I conducted my audit of the financial statements in accordance with generally accepted government auditing standards.

### Scope of the audit of the financial statements

An audit involves obtaining evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatement, whether caused by fraud or error. This includes an assessment of: whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority's circumstances and have been consistently applied and adequately disclosed; and the overall presentation of the financial statements. If I become aware of any apparent material misstatements or inconsistencies I consider the implications for my certificate.

I am required to obtain evidence sufficient to give reasonable assurance that the expenditure and income recorded in the financial statements has been applied to the purposes intended by the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority Act 2000 and the

financial transactions recorded in the financial statements conform to the authorities, which govern them.

## Opinion on regularity

In my opinion, in all material respects, the expenditure and income recorded in the financial statements have been applied to the purposes intended by the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority Act 2000 and the financial transactions recorded in the financial statements conform to the authorities that govern them.

# Opinion on financial statements

In my opinion, the financial statements give a true and fair view of the revenue collected and expenses paid by the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority during the financial year ended 31 March 2015 and the assets and liabilities arising from cash transactions as at the end of that period in accordance with the cash receipts and disbursements basis of accounting.

# Matters on which I report by exception

#### **Notes to the Accounts**

### 1. Accounting Policies

#### Basis of preparation of the accounts

The accounts of the Gibraltar Regulatory Authority have been prepared on a cash receipts and disbursements basis of accounting.

### 2. Revised Cost Allocation

### Rent, Rates and Service Charges

Water, Electricity, Cleaning, Repairs and Maintenance Expenditure has been deducted from Rent, Rates and Service Charges and included under General Expenses for each respective Division. 2013/2014 figures have also been revised accordingly for comparative purposes.

#### Capital Expenditure

Capital Expenditure items have also been revised and as a result £12,626.95 has been included in the Recurrent Account under Relocation Costs. These costs relate to repairs and general expenditure resulting from the relocation of GRA offices to new premises.
